

MOBILE PHONE

Rationale:

- To issue clear guidance for students, parents and staff on the use of mobile phones at School.
- To address concerns for individual privacy in regards to mobile phones with cameras and any other devices capable of capturing images.

Permission:

- If a phone or similar device is required by a student, that student must have written permission from his/her guardian/parent addressed to the principal.
- Parents wishing to make contact regarding their children throughout the school day should do so via the office.

Usage

- To avoid distraction in and out of the classroom, students must switch off and hand phones to the class teacher at the beginning of the school day and collect them when leaving the school.
