PRINCIPAL'S REPORT - June 25th

End of Term

We were so pleased to have our students back with us again after the 2 weeks of lockdown. We are all hoping that Term 3 is lockdown free. Hopefully the vaccine rollout will be ramped up and more of our community can receive their vaccinations sooner rather than later.

Dismissal will be at 2:30pm today. Aftercare will be available from 2:30pm until 6:15pm.

School resumes on Monday 12thJuly. We will have 3 new students starting with us - I am sure everyone will make them feel welcomed into our community.

I wish everyone a happy and refreshing break and look forward to seeing you at school again in third term.

Forthcoming Changes to Traffic and Parking for Term 3 – PLEASE TAKE NOTE

There will be <u>very significant changes to parking and traffic flows</u> in the streets surrounding Birralee PS beginning in Term 3. Please make sure you familiarise yourself with the <u>attached map</u> and read through <u>accompanying letter</u> from Manningham Council which details the changes.

Manningham Council is also going to undertake a pedestrian and traffic count at the intersection of Stanton Street and Heyington Avenue, where many students and parents cross to use the footbridge across the freeway.

Numerous parents and staff members have voiced concerns about near misses at that intersection. It may be that a supervised crossing is installed there should the pedestrian and vehicle count be high enough.

\$4.164 Million Capital Works Program

Jacque Clement, Tanya Burton and I, with input from parents, staff members and students, have been spending a great deal of time over the past four weeks, finalising the documentation required for our future building program. The documentation was finally uploaded yesterday to the Victorian School Building Authority (VSBA).

Today, I was contacted by Carmen from the VSBA to arrange for architects from three architectural firms to make a site visit to Birralee next Thursday. They will have access to the documentation we have submitted and gain local knowledge from the visit. Jacque Clement, Tanya Burton, our school council president Lisa Lavery, and I will also be onsite to assist with any questions asked by the architects.

The three architectural firms will then tender for the building project. Events are moving rapidly - what an exciting time for our school!

Please ensure children are signed in no later than 9am.





What to wear

During Winter, the mornings can be chilly, so please make sure you bring a warm top (clearly labelled) and keep an eye on the weather so your child is dressed appropriately. Some of our venues are particularly large and take time to warm up on the chillier mornings, so make sure the kids are rugged up. At TeamKids we love to get outside, so please remember to wear suitable footwear for running around.



Double check Teamkids Room Location

It is very important to double check our website prior to attending, in case of a room change. We are sometimes required to temporarily change rooms due to school building maintenance over the school holidays. Last minute changes will be announced via SMS to attending families.



Medical Information? Have a Plan

If your child has Asthma, Anaphylaxis, an Allergy or any other medical condition, upload plans to your TeamKids account and bring along a completed Risk Minimisation Form, found on our website. Please provide required medications to your venue coordinator on the first day of attendance - In their original packaging, clearly labelled with your child's name and a use-by date.

After your TeamKids booking is placed, you must log into your MyGov account to check you have a confirmed enrolment.



Extended Hours of operation

During the school holidays, our customer service team are available from 7:00 am till 6:30 pm.



Booking and cancellations

Bookings are subject to availability and may be placed/ amended until 11:59 pm the night prior to attendance via your TeamKids online account. An additional fee of \$5 per child applies to bookings made inside 7 days of attending. Cancellations must be received before 8am the day prior to attendance & are unable to be refunded to bank accounts, however, a non-expiring credit will be applied to your TeamKids account for use toward future bookings. Please refer to our website for full cancellation T&C's



Electronic Sign-In/out

All TeamKids venues require electronic sign in/out. Any person signing your child in or out from TeamKids care MUST be listed on your TeamKids account and know your TeamKids account pin number, if this has been activated. These details can be updated via your TeamKids account at any time.
