Basketball Courts

The Office

Toilets

Prep children use the toilets in the Prep building. Toilet doors will be open each morning from 8.30am. Students must always go to the toilet with a partner - be sure to ask your teacher before going!

Our Morning Routine

Every morning, all the Prep children line up at the basketball court. This is where your teacher will meet you in the mornings and after recess and lunch play each day, and where mum, dad or a trusted adult will wait to pick you up in the afternoon.
